Hayatullah Jawad is founder and director of Afghan Human Rights Research and Advocacy Organization AHRRAO. He is studying his master degree on Human Rights in Friedrich Alexander University Erlangen-Nuremberg. He received his bachelor degree from Persian Literature Faculty of Balkh University. He worked as Field Monitoring Officer and as well as Monitoring and Investigation Senior Assistant for about 10 years in Afghanistan Independent Human Rights Commission north regional office, Civic Education Officer in Afghanistan Joint Election Management Body Secretariat north regional office, Child Protection officer in Save the Children UK and had membership of EU Election monitoring team in the northern Afghanistan during 2009 presidential election.

In the framework of AHRRAO, Jawad had close partnership with German Federal Foreign office, Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ), Freie Universität Berlin, Analysis Research Consulting ARC, Berghof Foundation, USIP and Max Plank Institute for the Rule of Law. At the national level, he has close cooperation with Hamida Barmaki Organization for the Rule of Law, Afghanistan Independent Human Rights Commission, Afghanistan Civil Society Forum ACSF, Mediotik Afghanistan and other national, regional and provincial level governmental and none-governmental organization.

He is also working as freelance consultant and has working experience with different international organization including but not limited to Aga Khan Development Network AKDN, ARC, GIZ and Madiba Consulting Company in northern Afghanistan. In addition, he is member of Afghanistan Constitutional Studies Institute ACSI which is established and supported by Max Plank Institute for the Rule of Law in Afghanistan.

Currently Jawad is working in Afghanistan and concentrating to strengthen ACSI's role to influence decision making in peace talks in Afghanistan through academic measures in order to keep the space open for civil and political activities in the future settlement of Afghanistan. In addition, he is establishing a credible network of intellectuals in the north and northeast regions with special focus on peace, justice and human rights. This initiative name is Justice Foundation for Peace and Human Rights (JF). JF is committed to support sustainable social peace countrywide. It is a progressive platform which conducts in-depth studies and run dialogues within a paradigm of effective cooperation among Afghans on the basic issues including countering extremism ideologies, stability, good governance and access to justice aiming to support sustainable peace and development in Afghanistan. Currently, activities of JF is stopped after escalation insecurity in the recent months and it will be resumed after reviewing the organization strategy according to the situation.

In his recent activities in the field of peace and human rights, Jawad has participated in Doha peace conference for Afghanistan in 2019 which was facilitated by Berghof Foundation and support by German Federal Foreign Office, ACSI workshop in New Delhi (outcome of workshop was an strategy paper [Towards a Constitutional Court in Afghanistan](#)) and other international and National conferences on Afghanistan Constitution, peace, stability and development, and represented Afghan intellectuals and Civil Society at the international conferences.

His experiences includes organizational management and implementation of complex field work in critical situation, excellent data collection and data management, conducting sensitive interviews in conflict zones, community mobilization, social organization, good negotiation skills with conflict parties and communities on their contribution for peace making and encouraging them to participate in the concerned projects aimed for future sustainability of their community.

He speaks English fluently and speaks Pashtu and Urdu well beside his mother tongue (Dari). He is also in the process of learning German language at A2.1 level.
